Launch Conference, Buenos Aires - Argentina Sponsorship Opportunities

The **International Level Crossing Awareness Day (ILCAD)** is a worldwide initiative to improve awareness of level crossing safety. Since 2009 the campaign has been spearheaded by the **International Union of Railways (UIC)**, the worldwide railway organisation, with the support of the railway community around the world. About 50 countries usually take part in the ILCAD annual campaign.

Each year, a partner country hosts the launch event where we may share good practices and projects to improve safety and reduce the accident toll. This conference attracts railway industry representatives, road authorities, academics, and many others from around the world who are working to raise awareness about the dangers surrounding level crossings.

200 people from 20 to 30 countries (representing all continents) come together at this event, where speakers present best practices on engineering and innovative solutions, enforcement, awareness and educational measures to improve safety at level crossings.

In 2024 the international conference to launch the 16th ILCAD campaign will be on 6 June in Buenos Aires - Argentina preceded by a conference on “Trespass and Suicide Prevention” on 5 June, and followed by technical visit on 7 June.

The public to target at ILCAD 2024: “Vulnerable users”.

The event is co-organised by the **International Union of Railways (UIC)** and the **Transportation Safety Board of Argentina (JST)**.
